McLaren Trophy America answers this question with a fresh, new single-make championship, where drivers race identical cars – the Artura Trophy EVO – putting the focus on the driver to make the difference.

The Artura Trophy EVO boasts 585PS, aggressive aerodynamics and Push-to-Pass making it capable of lapping within just seconds of a GT3 race car.

McLaren Trophy America is a 10-race championship, across five weekends, racing on some of America's most iconic racetracks including, Sonoma, Sebring, Road America and Indianapolis.

For the first time ever, in 2026 McLaren Trophy America drivers will race alongside the McLaren Formula One at the Miami Grand Prix for what promises to be a truly exceptional weekend.

Drivers enjoy a great level of track time each weekend which culminates in two 50-minute action-packed races.

Drivers compete in three distinct classes: Pro, Pro-AM and AM to ensure they're always going wheel-to-wheel with drivers of similar skill and experience. So, whether you are an amateur 'AM' driver looking to hone your skill, or a young 'PRO' in search of the ultimate proving-ground, McLaren Trophy is the perfect racing platform.

All ten races are streamed to tens of thousands of fans, and state-of-the-art facilities – inspired by the McLaren Formula One team – offer the chance to experience what it means to be a McLaren racing driver.

McLaren Trophy America races alongside the Fanatec GT World Challenge America powered by AWS.

The McLaren Artura Trophy Evo is our dedicated race car designed exclusively for our McLaren Trophy championships.

With 585PS, it is sensationally quick in a straight line. Coupled with an enhanced aerodynamics package, it is supremely agile in both low and high-speed corners, making it capable of lapping within just seconds of a GT3 car.

Artura Trophy Evo debuts innovative 'Push to Pass' technology that increases the power to 620PS for 300 seconds each race in inject further excitement as teams engage strategy to deploy the additional power for an all-out attack or a critical defence.

The Artura Trophy Evo also features wider tyres, new suspension uprights and upgraded anti-roll bars to generate even greater traction and stability to instill yet more confidence for the driver as they go wheel-to-wheel at some of the world's most iconic race tracks.


CHAMPIONSHIP CATEGORIES

All drivers race in identical Artura Trophy Evo race cars and compete in one of three main categories:

CATEGORY	FIA GRADING	PAIR or SOLO	QUALIFYING	RACE STARTS	PIT WINDOW
PRO	Silver	Pair	Each driver must do one qualifying session	Each driver must start the race they qualified for	20 th – 30 th minute (50:50 split)
PRO-AM	Bronze & Silver/Gold/Platinum	Pair	Each driver must do one qualifying session	Each driver must start the race they qualified for	20 th – 30 th minute (50:50 split)
AM	Bronze	Pair / Solo	Each driver must do one qualifying session	Each driver must start the race they qualified for	20 th – 30 th minute (50:50 split)

Please Note: The official FIA Driver Categorisation list will be used to determine a driver's class.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

McLaren Trophy has a new points structure for 2026, designed to reward the achievements of the best drivers, and keep the championship battle alive until the flag drops at the final race of the season.

Drivers score points in their championship category based on the below finishing positions:

1st	12 points
2nd	9 points
3rd	7 points
4th	5 points
5th	4 points
6th	3 points
7th	2 points
8th	1 point

In addition, the final championship standings will be taken from a driver's top 9 scores, allowing drivers to drop their one weakest score.

MORE TO FIGHT FOR ...

PAPAYA CUP

In addition to the official Pro, Pro-AM and AM categories, McLaren Trophy boasts a sub-category - **The Papaya Cup** - to recognise the achievements of AM drivers over a certain age or with limited race experience.

The Championship Organising Committee will accept a driver into the Papaya Cup category based on a number of conditions such as:

- An AM driver 60 years or older as of the date of Round 1.
- An AM driver, younger than 60 years, based on their previous experience or performances.

A podium after each race is held for the top three finishers within the Papaya Cup.

As the sister-series to McLaren Trophy America, McLaren Trophy Europe races on some of the world's most historic and iconic circuits, including the legendary Spa-Francorchamps and the storied 'Temple of Speed' at Monza.

Please note: All drivers require an International C licence or SRO Provisional licence, and teams require an SRO entrants' licence. Required driver license, crew and guest credential fees will need to be purchased separately from the SRO, in addition to the McLaren entry fees.


